

Factsheet – Culture and Leisure

- 32.3% of disabled people participated in at least one active sport in the past 12 months compared to 59.6% of non-disabled people. Disabled people also participate less in moderate intensity level sport at a level of 9.5% compared to 24.2% of non-disabled people.¹
- 24.1% of disabled people attended at least two arts events in the past 12 months compared to 36.3% of non-disabled people.
- 18.9% of disabled people participated in arts at least twice in the last 12 months compared to 25.6% of non-disabled people.
- Less disabled people than non disabled people visited the cinema at least once in the last 12 months with about 3 in 10 disabled people visiting the cinema compared to almost 6 in 10 non-disabled people.
- Although a gap still exists between disabled and non-disabled people in using a library, the gap is narrower than other types of arts/sports/leisure events with 5 in 10 non-disabled people using a library within the previous 12 months compared to 4 in 10 disabled people.
- Almost a third of disabled people visited a museums/gallery in the last 12 months compared to nearly half of non-disabled people.
- 59.5% of disabled people visited a Historical Environment at least once in the previous twelve months compared to 72.7% of non-disabled people.

¹ Moderate intensity level sport – participation in at least 30 minutes of moderate intensity level sport on at least three separate occasions in the past week
