We open on the exterior of a building site.

Cut to a bricklayer wearing a hard hat and working on a building site.
Sign on board reads: **Disabled**

We cut to him pouring a cup of tea from his thermos flask.
Sign reads: **Enabled**

Cut to a woman behind a desk. She talks to camera.
LED Display reads: **Disabled**

Cut to her serving a customer. Cut quickly to her manager. Cut back to her.
Display reads: **Enabled**

Cut to her at her desk with her manager standing behind her.

Man: I'm a builder and I have diabetes.

My boss lets me have a few short breaks during the day so that I can manage my blood glucose levels.

Woman: I'm a travel assistant and I'm hard of hearing.

My employers have installed a loop system to help me and I also sign, so I can help other customers like me.
