

## **High Life: Transcript**

This is the script for a DWP public information film about visual impairments.

The camera opens in the busy offices of an Adventure Holiday's company, A plasma screen exciting action shots of images of skydivers, bungee jumpers, white water rafting and all manner of adventurous activities. We see other people working in the background. A telephone rings and we see a young woman answer the call via her headset.

**Woman:** High-life adventure, Anna speaking. How can I help you?

We cut to a man in his early thirties speaking in his front room.

**Man:** Yeah hi. Can you let me know what activities you offer

We then cut between them as the conversation progresses.

**Woman:** How about the 'Aerial Package' - sky diving, bungee jumping and para-sailing.

**Man:** Oh, I don't know about that?

**Woman:** Oh, it's a real buzz, I did it last week.

**Man:** I have a problem ...(pause)

**Woman:** A problem sir?

**Man:** Oh nothing serious, I just don't have a head for heights.

**Woman:** (Laughing) That could be a problem...

The camera for the first time reveals that the woman is blind and we watch as she checks what other options are available.

**Woman:** (continuing)... how about the 'Native American Package' – kayaking, archery and horse riding.

**Man:** (taken aback) Horse-riding?

**Woman:** I'm told that they are quite small horses.
